AUGUST 24 – TOP OF THE ROCK LOST CANYON CAVE AND NATURE TRAIL OUTING

Club members will meet at the Ozark Walmart at 8:30 a.m. and caravan to Top of the Rock facility. Daily drivers are recommended rather than your classics. We plan to be assembled and ready to roll in the golf carts at 10:00 a.m. These times are listed to help those members who intend not to caravan but to drive separately to the event.

This is also the third Saturday of the month which means that Marco's Pizza



sponsors their cruise-in that starts at 4:00 p.m. So, hopefully, we will be able to take the tour, eat lunch, return home, and drive your classic to the cruise-in. That's our plan anyways.

The Lost Canyon Cave and Nature Trail is a 2 ½ mile trail accessible via golf cart that winds through nature and scenic views. Cost to enter Top of the Rock is \$5.00 per person. Cost to rent the golf carts is \$28.00 per person. The \$5.00 entry fee can be applied toward the cost of the golf cart rental or any other outlet at the facility. The golf cart rentals are on a first come, first serve basis. Club members who have taken this tour in the past speak highly of it and say it is well worth the cost.
