This cruise-in replaces Cruisin' USA venue which went out of business earlier this year.

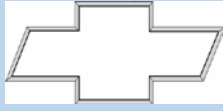

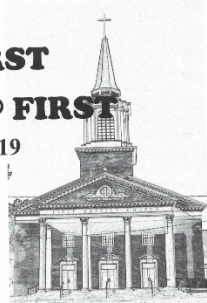
