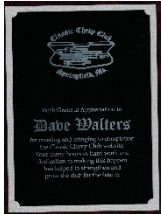

Bowerman Elementary School Cruise-in

On April 5, seven Classic Car Club members in five classics cruised to Bowerman Elementary School in Springfield along with club friends. A preschool teacher asked that we bring our cars to support the school's themed classes on Transportation.

Larry Fortner, Bobby Goss, Dennis Taube, Yvonna Davis, Melinda Owen, Jess Owen, Jack Wernet, and Dave Walters attended the cruise-in from the club. The group ate lunch at Kearney's Café on Kearney Street.

Bowerman Elementary, in Springfield, Missouri, is part of the Springfield R-XII district. The school reports enrolling

280 students in grades kindergarten through five, and it has 23 teachers on staff.

Bowerman Elementary School, founded in 1906, was named for Milton Bowerman. He served as judge of the Greene County Court and was a member of the school board for 38 years and was secretary for 37 years. The original four-room structure at Grand and High was used from 1906 to 1930 and was torn down in 1930 when the present Bowerman School was constructed. The school was then relocated to its current location at Douglas and High. In 1992, Bowerman underwent a building addition including several classrooms and a library. Bowerman was and still is a beautiful, two-story brick building where design elements from the past still live on.

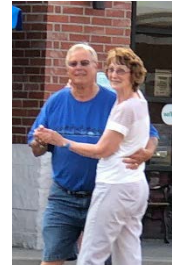

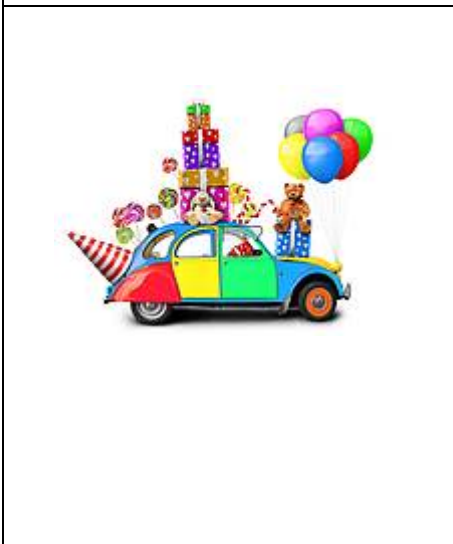

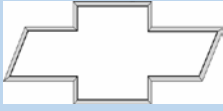

## Remember When.....

*A fun romp through the decades as we approach our clubs 45<sup>th</sup> anniversary in July 2020.*

### Highlights from 1930-1935...

Members with cars from these years are Jack and Donna Wernet - 1931 Ford Coupe, Jess and Melinda Owen - 1932 Ford 8 window coupe, Tom and Barb Trospen - 1933 Ford coupe, and Jake and Pam Lollar - 1934 Ford 8 window coupe and Wayne and Rita Bruffey - 1933 Ford coupe.

1931 was the first year Ford surpassed Chevrolet in production by 1100. Chevy took the honor back in 1932 and the first of many swaps for this title had begun. 1932 saw the first V8 engine for Ford with the standard roadster, coupe and phaeton all listed below \$500. The V8 had a top speed of 78 mph. Due to a rush to market there were many problems with the engine the first year but were quickly corrected with the V8 becoming known as a reliable engine making it a hot rodders favorite.
