Remember When.....

A fun romp through the decades as we approach our club's 45th anniversary in July 2020.

Highlights from 1941-1945...

1941 was a milestone year for Chevrolet. It was the first million-car model year which far outpaced Ford's production of 691,500 for the year. Styling refinements marked the war-shortened '42's. By the time the government halted civilian car production on February 1942, Chevy's model-year total was over a quarter-million units, of which less than 50,000 were built in calendar '42. Convertibles and wagons numbered only about 1000 each making them highly collectible to day.

Meanwhile Ford only sold 160,500 of the 1942 model year. Henry Ford quickly supported the war effort by turning out a variety of military vehicles including Jeeps (with American Bantam and Willys-Overland), and its new mile-long plant in Willow Run, Michigan, near Detroit, produced a variety of bombers through 1945. (Information adapted from *Encyclopedia of American Cars*.)

1942

- O'Reilly military hospital opens to treat WWII wounded in Springfield
- St Louis Cardinals won World Series

1944

• St Louis Cardinals won World Series • The 1944 World Series was the first played entirely west of the Mississippi River. St. Louis, then the westernmost outpost of Major League Baseball, hosted the series between the National League champion St. Louis Cardinals and the American League champion St. Louis Browns. All games were played at Sportsman's Park, home to both teams.

Nationally.....

George Washington Carver National Monument in Missouri preserves the birthplace and legacy of the famed African American scientist, educator and humanitarian. George Washington Carver reputedly discovered three hundred uses for peanuts and hundreds more for soybeans, pecans and sweet potatoes.

- Japan attacks Pearl Harbor
- Grand Coulee Dam begins to generate electricity
- Citizen Kane premieres in New York City
- Thanksgiving Day is established as 4th Thursday of November.
- Germany and Italy declare war on the United States. The U.S. responds in kind
- Art Garfunkel and Paul Simon born.

1942

• The Great Depression officially ends in the United States: With unemployment figures falling fast due to WWII-related employment, U.S. President Franklin D. Roosevelt closes the Works Progress Administration.

- Mick Jagger born
- Chevy Chase born

1945

WWII ended with the armistice of 14 August 1945 (V-J Day), followed by the formal surrender of Japan, which was on 2 September 1945 that officially ended the war in Asia.

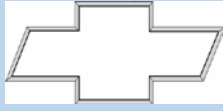

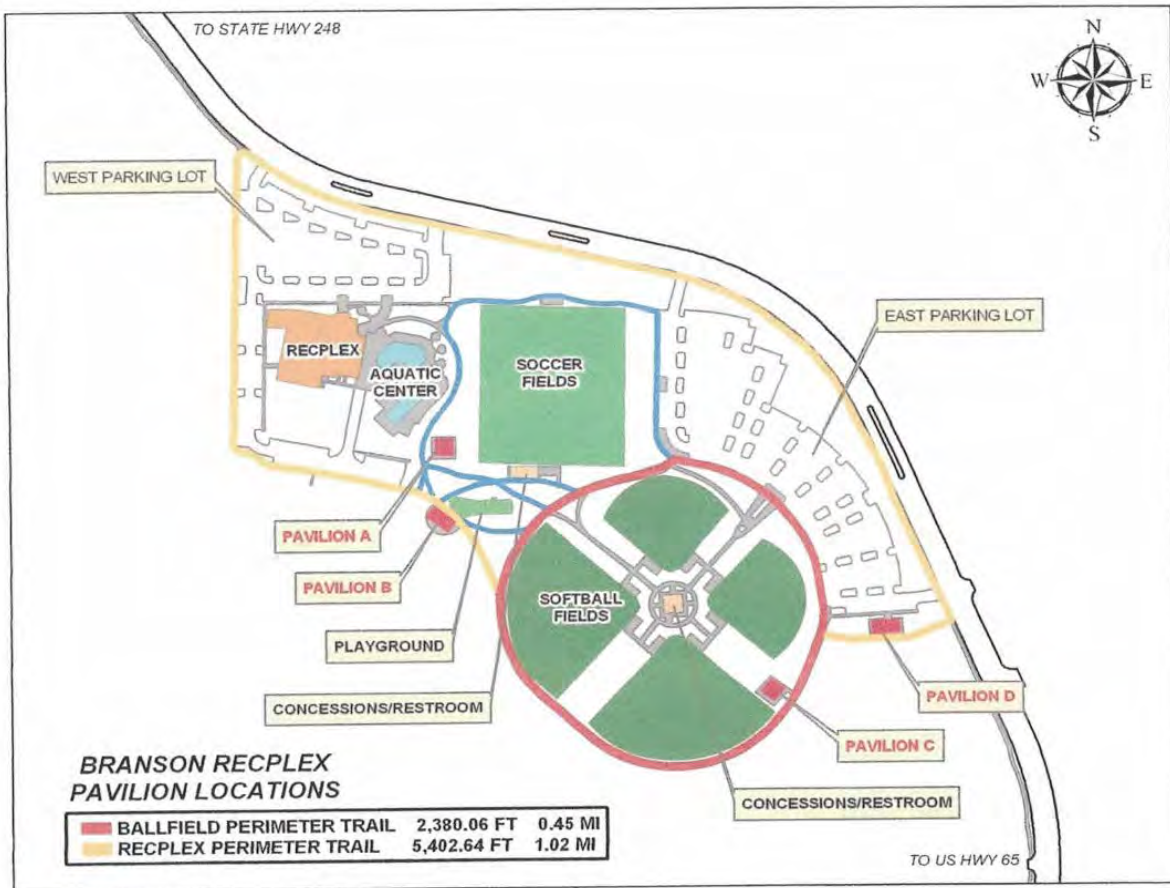

"Keep Watching The Ozarks" was on everybody's lips. Ralph Foster, as president and general manager of KWTO, devoted all his time and energy toward making KWTO the dominant station of the Ozarks area. KGBX was sold in the early 1940's.

Live talent broadcasts dominated programming. Many famous country music stars either got their start or appeared on KWTO, such as Slim Wilson, Porter Wagoner, Chet Atkins, the Carter family, and Homer and Jethro.

The long popular weekly television show, OZARK JUBILEE, was a Ralph Foster achievement through Crossroads TV Production, a KWTO subsidiary. It starred Red Foley and guest starred many well known country music personalities.

For many years, Ralph Foster had been collecting Native American artifacts. His interest in The School of the Ozarks prompted him to turn this vast collection over to The School's museum.

Because of his abiding interests and generosity, The School of the Ozarks Board of Trustees voted to rename the museum the "Ralph Foster Museum" in the mid-1960's.

Ralph Foster passed away on August 11, 1984. His wife Harriett passed away on December 5, 1986.

Who was Ralph Foster? He was an avid hunter and fisherman, a strong conservationist; a man who was close to nature, one who loved his fellow man. He was compassionate, understanding, generous, and had a rich sense of humor.



WHO WAS RALPH FOSTER?

Ralph Foster was one of the true pioneers of radio. He was one of the first to realize its vast potential, both educationally and as a new and exciting field of mass entertainment.

In 1924, Ralph Foster and his partner, Jerry Hall, set up a 50-watt station, KGBX, in a corner of their Firestone tire store in St. Joseph, Missouri.

It began simply as a hobby, but as businesses increasingly sought to advertise over the air, the station blossomed into a full-time vocation. It wasn't long before a brand new one-stop super service station and glassed in studios for the radio station were built a few blocks north of the old tire store located on Frederick Avenue. The age of radio had begun!

In 1932, Ralph Foster moved the station to Springfield, Missouri. Later, unable to get a power increase for KGBX, he purchased the license of a radio station in Grant City, Missouri, and moved it to Springfield.

Ralph Foster asked for and received the call letter KWTO and soon the slogan

EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The Ralph Foster Museum offers several educational programs for the younger museum visitors. A hands-on Children's Discovery Room is available free of charge to children ages 4-9 and is open Monday through Friday. A one child/one adult ratio is required to visit the Discovery Room or a four to one ratio for school groups is required. Reservations for the room are required for school groups.

Loan kits are available for area schools, which contain artifacts, text, audio, and worksheets, and may be loaned to a class for a period of five days. A brochure is available which lists the kit contents and loan instructions.

Educational groups are welcome at the Ralph Foster Museum. We ask that you call the museum in advance to arrange your self guided tour. The museum provides a packet of information for each student to make their visit more interesting.
