Dinner Outing Smith's Restaurant – Collins, MO

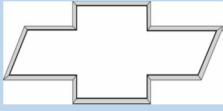

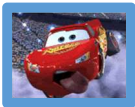

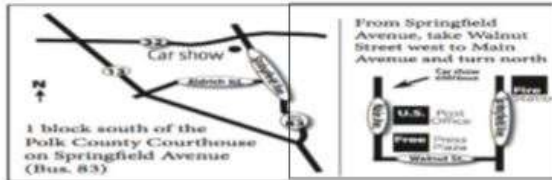
