Welcome to America's Largest Block Party. Cruisin' The Coast® began in 1996 as a festival to celebrate antique, classic and hot rod vehicles, nostalgic music and related events. 374 vehicles registered that first year and in 2017 we had 8,308 registered vehicles. Car enthusiasts from 40 states plus Canada, Germany and Puerto Rico arrive on the Mississippi Gulf Coast once a year to showcase their rides and to cruise our beautiful 30-mile stretch of beach-side highway with designated stops in Bay St. Louis, Biloxi, D'Iberville, Gulfport, Pass Christian, Ocean Springs and Pascagoula. Each venue is set up as a mini festival with a stage for live bands, reserved parking for registered cruisers, spectator parking, and vendors for food and event merchandise. Registered cruisers will receive an ID card in their registration packets to exhibit all week in their car's front window; this ID allows entry into the venues where reserved parking is available. A program with maps will also be part of the registration packet so cruisers can plan their individual schedules as this is an open cruise – events are scheduled and you decide which ones you are interested in attending. Our weeklong event includes cruise-ins, a Salute To Our Veterans event, car auction, swap meet, car corral, and a parade. Spectators are welcome and will find that our cruisers love to talk “old cars.”


Our club's contingent of car enthusiasts will report back after the show with stories and more. There will be a full layout in next month's newsletter.

REVISED BY-LAWS, OCTOBER 21, 2018

Requirements for Membership

1. It is not necessary to own a 55-72 Chevy, but a sincere interest in these cars is necessary.
2. You need not be affiliated with a national club.
3. One membership is required per household.

Dues

1. The Springfield Chapter dues are \$24 annually (effective as of August, 1994). All dues will be considered due in August.
2. Member's annual dues not paid within 60 days will be dropped from the Club.
3. New member's dues will be pro-rated at \$2.00 per month.
4. The National membership dues are currently \$35.00 per year.
5. No refund of dues will be made if a member drops out of the Club.

Rules for Membership

1. It should be each member's duty (through the enjoyment of their cars and Club) to actively encourage membership to all prospective members.
2. Only members and guests may attend Club functions/events. Prospective members may attend if invited by a member.
3. Only members may vote on Club business.
4. Members may vote absentee on any up-coming motion by contacting the President or any Officer before the meeting.
5. All by-laws standing, and/or amendments to by-laws, require a 2/3 majority of those members in attendance. All other motions require a simple majority.

Election of Officers

Nominations of Officers will be made from the floor during official Club meetings in June and July. Voting will take place at the August meeting (by ballot, if necessary, for dual nominees). The candidates receiving the highest number of votes will be elected to a one-year term and take office.

Rules for Officers

1. Any Officer will be removed from office if he or she misses three consecutive meetings without due cause.
2. The President/Vice President can approve expenditures for up to \$150.00 with a 2/3 majority vote of the elected Officers.* These expenditures can be made only for items necessary to support Club activities, meetings, functions and necessary operational expenses.

* Elected Officers include President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer.

Meeting Procedures/Parliamentary Procedures

1. Call the meeting to order
2. Recognize visitors and new members
3. Roll call
4. Treasurer's report
5. Secretary's report
6. Open the floor for discussion of any old business
7. Open the floor for discussion of any new business
8. Adjournment, only after all motions made during the meeting have been defeated, passed or tabled.

Officers' Duties

President:	Conduct meetings in a business-like manner. Show good representation of the Classic Chevy Club.
Vice President:	Conduct meeting during the absence of the President. When necessary, advise other Officers.
Secretary:	Keep accurate minutes of all meetings. Work with the Activity Director to handle all correspondence. Keep records of Club activities.
Treasurer:	Collect dues. Keep an accurate record of all finances and expenses.
Editor:	Publish a "Bow Tie" Newsletter each month (or whenever necessary) to keep members advised of news about past or upcoming events, birthdays, anniversaries or other helpful information.
Activity Director:	Suggest activities or gather information on upcoming events. Work with the Secretary to handle correspondence. Be responsible for the recognition of the outgoing President.
Sergeant at Arms:	Keep order during all Club functions.

The Club reserves the right to have the Sergeant at Arms ask any unruly Club member or visitor to leave the meeting or Club function.

A copy of these By-Laws shall be provided to each current member and a copy shall be attached to all Applications given to new members.

The Baptist Home Ozark Outreach

The Baptist Home Ozark is strategically situated in Southwest Missouri, making it attractive to those interested in a more suburban lifestyle. Springfield (Missouri's third-largest city) is a ten minute drive North, Branson is 30 minutes South and the famous Lambert's Cafe (Home of Throed Rolls) is just one mile from the campus.
